This chocolate retailer and restaurant in Back Bay has so many warm chocolate options, perfect for snowy days. There are seasonal specials along with the usual dark, milk, or white chocolate beverages, including a classic whipped hot chocolate; a thick version with vanilla ice cream; a cup that comes with red chili, cinnamon, nutmeg, and pepper; a Swiss whipped version topped with whipped cream; and even peanut butter, hazelnut, and mocha versions.
