Max Brenner is obviously known for its chocolate concoctions, but it doesn't skimp on the savory apps either. In fact, there's a whole section of the menu with great things to dip. The spinach and artichoke fondue is rich and creamy — perfect for scooping up with warm chili tortilla chips. For variety, try the Mediterranean dip trio, which includes hummus, babaganoush and Spanish eggplant dip. Served with spicy pita chips, it's \$13.75 for a sharable portion or \$7.95 for one. Or, to satisfy your sweet tooth, order one of the many chocolate fondues, all available in single servings or for sharing between two. The selection ranges from classic fondue with bananas, strawberries and marshmallows for dipping to more creative options like sugar churros. With warm toffee sauce, muddled raspberries and your choice of white, dark or milk chocolate, this is a treat worth splurging on.
